    - i. Hiring teachers to deliver education programs including extended transition programs
    - ii. Hiring and training custodial and administrative staff to support students in their safe return to schools and to implement school safety plans
    - iii. Purchasing additional non-medical masks or other personal protective equipment
    - iv. Improving ventilation and air systems in schools
    - v. Increasing hand hygiene, including additional handwashing and hand sanitizing stations
    - vi. Cleaning equipment and supplies
    - vii. Mental health support
    - viii. Software and computer or tablet loans for students learning remotely; and
    - ix. Additional transportation costs to accommodate additional routes and enhanced cleaning
  - c. Provincial health guidelines on physical activity has been updated, physical education and extracurricular exercise and sport activities should occur outside whenever possible

     Harley Rollins noted that the shift is away from vigorous activity when indoors, Doug Park has advised that during there is a health and safety committee that goes through safety checks when reviewing things like this. At this time the allocation of how the funds are spent are decided at the district level not at the individual school level.
