- b. District/School Enrollment
 - o 570 new enrollments, continuing to receive more coming into our district
 - Staff had to reorganize all classes when we got asked to have another division, and then got asked to do so again
 - o So far only have added students that are within our own catchment
 - o Why are class placements not happening earlier? Is it possible to move the timeline up?
 - Not every school is able to predict their student volumes, many variables that impact how quickly a school is able to confirm how many students are going to be arriving
 - Extra space year to- year may also be different, impacting the ability to make decisions too far in advance
- c. Staffing/New staff
 - Currently looking for a teacher to fill a grade 6/7 class and a grade 1/2 class
 - Currently 1 resource teaching spot will be shared between Ms. Ng and Mr. Unger, will need to fill one more resource spot in addition to this.
 - o EA's are stable this year, all 14 that were here last year have returned this year

6. Treasurer's Report

- a. Current Balance of our operating account is \$31,308.80, however we have already allotted funds for the following items: \$1500 for books, \$1000 manipulatives, \$1000 for iPads which are to still be purchased this year
- General commitments made last year that have now been paid: \$525 for grade 7 pictures, \$260 for the Munchalunch program, bringing our operating account to\$27,023.80
- c. Gaming Account current balance of \$68.00 which we're expecting to zero out once the last cheque has been cashed, we're projecting about \$8,000 coming in to our gaming funds this year when funds arrive. Gaming funds are from the government, and there are specific eligibility criteria for the use of gaming funds.
