District Universal Hot Lunch

Utilizing Feeding Futures as well as National School Food Program funding, the Richmond School District will be piloting a universal hot lunch program at selected elementary and secondary schools. It is anticipated that a lunch will be offered to all students at McNeely Elementary School once each month beginning Friday, March 6, 2026. We will be using the MunchaLunch ordering platform which families use to order other hot lunches from the school.

The following dates have been scheduled for McNeely:

- March 6, 2026 (ordering closes 9PM on Feb. 27)
- April 17, 2026 (ordering closes 9PM on Apr. 10)
- May 1, 2026 (ordering closes 9PM on Apr. 24)
- June 5, 2026 (ordering closes 9PM on May 29)



These dates are separate from our McNeely PAC Hot Lunch dates. Families can order ONE MEAL PER CHILD at no cost.

Families with an EXISTING MunchaLunch account for ordering PAC hot lunches will now see a separate profile called 'Feeding Futures' on their account. Please use your existing login and password for MunchaLunch to view and order. Participation is optional and the vendors for universal hot lunch have provided menu accommodations for different dietary considerations. Different sizes of meals are also available.

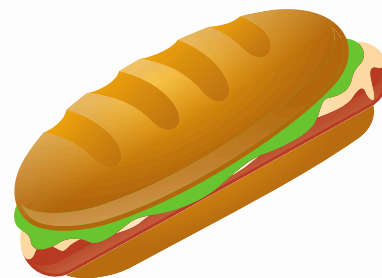

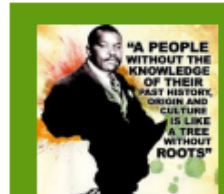

Celebrations in our Community

February 15, 2026 – Maha Shivaratri (Hindu)

Warm wishes to members of the Hindu community observing Maha Shivaratri, the “Great Night of Lord Shiva.” — honouring the triumph of light over darkness and the power of spiritual renewal. May this observance bring peace, strength, and spiritual renewal.

Translation note: Maha Shivaratri (महाशिवरात्रि) means “Great Night of Shiva.”

Pronounced: **MAH-ha SHIH-vah-rah-tree.**

February 17, 2026 – Lunar New Year (Chinese, Taiwanese, Korean, Vietnamese, and several Southeast Asian communities)

Happy Lunar New Year to all who celebrate! As you welcome the Year of the Horse, may this time of renewal bring joy, connection, and hope to you and your families.

Translation note: Known as Chūn Jié (春节) in Mandarin, Seollal (설날) in Korean, and Tết Nguyên Đán in Vietnamese.

Pronounced: **Choon-jyeh, Suhl-lahl, Tet Nguyen Dan.**

February 17 (or February 18- ~March 18), 2026 – Beginning of Ramadhan (Islamic)

We extend our best wishes to the Muslim students, staff, and families as the holy month of Ramadhan begins. May this holy month of reflection, fasting, giving to charity and community continue to foster compassion, gratitude, and spiritual renewal for you and your loved ones.

Translation note: Ramadhan (Arabic: رَمَضَان, often spelled Ramadan) meaning “heat”, as the month originally was supposed to fall on the hottest months.

Pronounced: **RAH-mah-dhan or RAH-mah-zan.**

February 18, 2026 – Ash Wednesday (Christian)

To the Christian students, staff, and families preparing for the Lenten season: we send warm greetings on Ash Wednesday, as this day marks a time of reflection, renewal, and preparation. May you find meaning in the season ahead as you journey toward Easter.

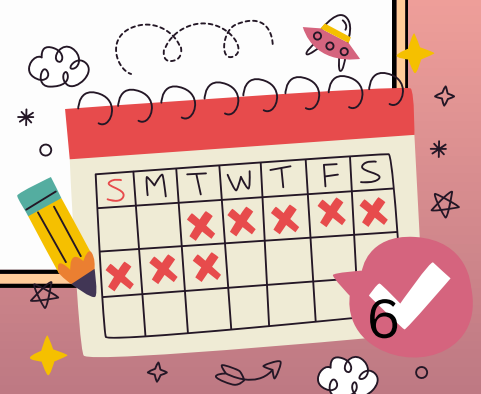
